Public Health Priorities 2022/23 (West Sussex Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy 2019-2024)

## Report by Alison Challenger, Director of Public Health

### **Summary**

Following the Director of Public Health's (DPH's) report and presentation to the Board on 'Public health priorities 2022/23; forward planning for local implementation of national public health policy' at its meeting on 28 April 2022, the DPH will deliver a presentation to the Health and Wellbeing Board (HWB) on the Board's Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy 2019-2024, including the impact of COVID-19 and health inequalities, the role of the HWB, and the development and implementation of the Integrated Care System (ICS) for Sussex and how it will interface with HWBs to identify priorities for each place within the ICS.

This item will further contribute to identifying priorities for the Board's workplan for 2022/23 to tackle issues locally, to improve the health of the population and reduce health inequalities across West Sussex.
