Purpose	<p>The County Council's Integrated Parking Strategy (IPS) was previously reviewed in 2014 and, in the context of recent changes in national, regional and local conditions, requires a further review.</p> <p>The revised IPS will cover the period to 2024 and will seek to ensure that the County Council's parking policies remain appropriate and effective at meeting the needs of local communities, its traffic management responsibilities and the wider policies and agenda.</p> <p>The IPS will sit within and contribute towards the County Council's wider transport, economic, community, environment, and health strategies.</p>
Decision	<p>The Cabinet Member for Highways and Infrastructure has:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Approved the changes to on-street parking charges set out at paragraph 2 and detailed in Appendix A; and2. Authorised the Director of Law and Assurance to take all necessary action to bring the changes to on-street charges into effect from January 2021.
