Purpose	<p>The use of physical infrastructure to protect bus gates/routes has traditionally been employed in West Sussex but this has proven costly and unreliable</p> <p>Automatic number plate recognition enforcement cameras (ANPR) are routinely used by many local authorities as a more cost effective and reliable method of control than Bus Gates. The County Council does not currently exercise bus lane enforcement powers.</p> <p>The installation of ANPR cameras will be funded from Section 106 funds. The long term maintenance and replacement of equipment will be funded by the enforcement of the regulations.</p>
Decision	The Cabinet Member for Highways and Infrastructure has approved the introduction of the civil enforcement of bus gate contraventions in West Sussex using automatic number plate recognition cameras.
