### Urgent Action

The following decision has been taken under the urgent action procedure by the Director of Law and Assurance, in consultation with the Chairman of the Crawley County Local Committee and relevant Scrutiny Committee Chairman.

<b>Purpose</b>	<p>The proposal relates to a request from residents of Langley Green for parking restrictions in a residential area in the vicinity of community health centre, shops and school. Obstructive and inconsiderate parking in Langley Drive and at other nearby locations restricts access and visibility for traffic entering and leaving the roads making the roads unsafe for both drivers and pedestrians. Inconsiderate parking for nearby shops &amp; medical centre obstructs access and there is evidence of damaged kerbs &amp; grass verges in Langley Drive &amp; Leveret Lane.</p> <p>Following the Statutory Public Consultation, between 28th October 2020 and 25th November 2020, there were 14 objections received, along with 2 expressions of support. All objections are included in Appendix B to this report.</p>
<b>Decision</b>	<p>The Director of Law and Assurance, in consultation with the Chairman of the Crawley County Local Committee and the Chairman of the Environment and Communities Scrutiny Committee, has used his delegated powers under Standing Order 3.45 to decide the following:</p> <p>That Crawley CLC having considered the objections to the scheme, and the responses in Appendix B, and authorise the Director of Law and Assurance to make the order as advertised except for the amendments as detailed in the revised scheme referred to in paragraph 2.3 and attached in Appendix C.</p>
<b>Interest and nature of interest declared</b>	None
<b>Reason for urgency</b>	The urgency of this matter is because all County Local Committee meetings have been cancelled due to the ongoing public health emergency. However, there are decisions required before the next round of meetings and it was agreed that the urgent action procedure should be used for these decisions.
