Purpose	The Boundary Commission for England has launched a Parliamentary Boundary Review and is consulting on a proposed scheme for constituencies in England. The County Council is able to respond to the consultation, as may any other individuals, organisations and councils. The County Council's advisory Electoral Review Panel met to consider the proposed scheme and came up with revised proposals that it felt would be better for West Sussex.
	The consultation closes before the next meeting of Governance Committee. Cllr Pete Bradbury, as Chairman of the Governance Committee, has been consulted and the Director of Law and Assurance is therefore taking the decision under Standing Order 3.45.
Decision	That the proposed response to the Boundary Commission's consultation as outlined in Appendix A be approved as the County Council's response to the consultation.

Reason for urgency	The Boundary Commission for England is consulting on a possible model of future Parliamentary constituencies. The consultation closes on 2 August, so there is not time to wait until the next meeting of the Governance Committee on 6 September.
