Purpose	The County Council has a statutory duty to provide sufficient school places for all children who need a place. This report seeks approval for the allocation of capital funding from the Basic Need Capital Programme to undertake an expansion project to provide a new school hall at Nyewood CE Junior School that will provide sufficient and suitable accommodation for the previous increase in pupil numbers from 75 to 90 pupils in each year group.
