<b>Purpose</b>	<p>The One Public Estate Programme (OPE) is an established national initiative which aims to improve service delivery through co-location and integration of services and rationalise the public estate thereby generating revenue savings and securing capital receipts from the disposal of surplus land and assets.</p> <p>As part of the One Public Estate West Sussex Programme, a project is being brought forward to create a new Blue-Light operational and training centre at Highwood, Horsham. This is planned to provide a new fire station, a new, centralised Fire &amp; Rescue Service training centre and facilities for joint training across the blue-light sector.</p>
<b>Decision</b>	<p>The Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources has approved:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Funding as set out at paragraph 4.3, that £1.5m of capital funding be allocated from the OPE Programme to fund the detailed building and infrastructure design of the scheme in 2019/20; and</li><li>2. Delegates authority to the Executive Director Economy, Infrastructure and Environment for the appointment of technical advisers to progress this project through detailed design and the preparation and submission of a planning application.</li></ol>
