

## West Sussex County Council

### Proposed Executive Decision for **20 December 2019** call-in deadline **5 p.m. on 3 January 2020**

The following proposed decision has been endorsed by the Cabinet Member and will come into effect at the end of the call-in period unless the call-in procedure is activated.

<b>Decision Title &amp; Ref No:</b>	Review of on-street parking charges and related policy - phase two HI18 (19/20)

<b>Key Decision</b>	Yes
<b>Purpose</b>	<p>As Highway Authority, the County Council is responsible for managing on-street parking. This includes setting on-street parking charges at appropriate levels to deliver the County Council's objectives for parking management, as set out in the Integrated Parking Strategy.</p> <p>The on-street parking charges review for 2019/20 has been carried out in two phases, the first of which was <a href="#">approved</a> by the Cabinet Member for Highways and Infrastructure in July 2019. This second phase outlines options for a further review of some on-street parking charges, all of which will require a separate TRO advertisement. These include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A new 6-month Resident, Non-Resident, Healthcare, Carer, Countywide, Trader and Doctor permit</li><li>• A standard cost for Hotel permits (Worthing only)</li><li>• Changes to the charges in Crawley Library Car Park</li><li>• For Resident and Non-Resident permits, a proposed reduction for low emission vehicles</li></ul> <p>The options under consideration included adjustments to parking charges to make improvements to the administration of the residents' parking schemes, correcting any imbalance that exists between the on and off-street charges in some towns, taking account of inflation and helping to facilitate future improvements in service provision.</p>
<b>Decision</b>	<p>The Cabinet Member for Highways and Infrastructure has approved:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) the changes to on-street charges and permits as set out in section 2 and Appendix A; and</li></ol>

	2) authorised the Director of Law and Assurance to advertise the Traffic Regulation Orders and, subject to the receipt of no significant objections, to implement the proposed changes.
