

- **514/SC – The Academy of Gym** – The Committee deferred this project at the March meeting pending further information surrounding Company and Financial status. This evidence has now been provided, please refer to page 3-10 of the attached Crowdfunding Application Pack.
- **571/SC – My Sisters' House Women's Centre** – project has also pitched to Joint Western Arun Area for funding consideration – the Chairman may wish to agree a matched pledge with the Chairman of JWAAC.
