Emergency Active Travel Fund (tranche 1) – temporary pop-up cycle schemes

I am writing to advise of the intention for an officer to authorise the above matter that requires an urgent decision; I enclose a copy of the report.

The report recommends that the additional capital allocation of £0.547m to the highways capital budget and the additional £0.234m to the highways revenue budget is noted; approves the implementation of the seven schemes outlined in Appendix A of the report (via the Balfour Beatty Living Places contract); and delegates authority to the Director of Highways, Transport and Planning, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Highways and Infrastructure, to subsequently amend or remove schemes as part of dynamic monitoring.

The decision is urgent due to challenging government timescales for commencement and implementation of the schemes.
