Cycling and Walking Executive Task and Finish Group

The Cabinet Member for Highways and Infrastructure has appointed an Executive Task and Finish Group (TFG) to assist in the overall review of the County Council's approach to cycling and walking particularly in respect of the schemes being developed for the Emergency Active Travel Fund (tranches one and two) and the review of the Walking and Cycling Strategy.

Under its [terms of reference](#) the TFG is expected to meet five times, though there may be a need for ad hoc meetings should circumstances dictate. The first meeting was held on 24 July and further meetings will continue into the autumn/winter.

Horsham Fire Station and Fire and Rescue Training Centre Task and Finish Group

The Performance and Finance Scrutiny Committee and the Fire & Rescue Service Scrutiny Committee have agreed that a Task and Finish Group (TFG) should be convened to undertake pre-decision scrutiny on the proposed decision in the [Forward Plan](#) concerning proposals and funding arrangements for the development of a Fire Station and Fire and Rescue Training Centre on County Council land west of Horsham, with a view to submission for planning permission.

The membership of the TFG has been drawn from both committees and is as follows:
