Meeting cancellations

County Local Committees - autumn round

The Governance Committee decided at its meeting on 7 September to cancel the County Local Committee (CLC) meetings scheduled for October and November 2020. This includes the Joint Area Committees in Arun. This was in recognition of the additional staff resources required to support virtual meetings (including Services which are heavily committed to the Council's COVID-19 response) and to ensure there is both member and staff capacity to deal with the business anticipated to dominate the Council's agenda in the autumn.

Alternative decision-making arrangements are being put in place for the allocation of Community Initiative Funding and the prioritisation of Traffic Regulation Orders. The Governance Committee will review whether the CLC meetings in February/March 2021 should be held at its meeting on 18 January 2020.
