Winter Gritter Fleet Procurement

A [key decision](#) to authorise the commencement of a procurement for the supply of de-icing salt and provision of a gritter fleet was made by the Cabinet

Member for Highways and Infrastructure in August. Subsequently, the Director of Highways, Transport and Planning has made a [minor change to that decision](#) (PDF, 70KB) by splitting the procurement of the gritter fleet into two separate tenders of one year and three years, instead of one four-year contract. All other aspects of the original decision are unchanged.

Horsham Enterprise Park site works begin

Essential site preparation works will begin next week at Horsham Enterprise Park in Wimblehurst Road, Horsham. The works, being carried out by Axio (Special Works) Limited, are due to be completed in five months' time.

Preparatory work taking place on site includes disposal of building waste, maintenance and the internal strip-out of the central buildings, ground preparation, tree root protection and putting up perimeter hoardings.

These works mark the next phase in the County Council delivering the ambition to regenerate the site formerly owned by Novartis Pharmaceuticals into a mixed, high quality residential and commercial scheme to boost the local economy. Find out more in a [press release](#) issued.
