The County Council is consulted on a Public Path Stopping up and Diversion Order to be made by Horsham District Council in respect of footpath 2360 under the provisions of S257 of the Town and Country Planning Act to enable a replacement dwelling in accordance with planning permission applied for but not yet granted. The diversion will place a length of approximately 450 metres of the path onto the southern and eastern sided of paddocks to the south east of Palacelands Farm.

This is an amended Order following an earlier Order made for the same proposal on 27 October 2020 to which the County Council entered a holding objection owing to inaccuracy in the plan and insufficient detail about the proposed route. These issues have now been corrected by the new Order.
