In order to deliver this event safely, we've taken the decision with West Sussex County Council to keep motorists and cyclists separate, so some roads within the county will be closed during the day.





FAQ's



During the communications process, which began in February, we have received approximately 300 emails and 50 voicemails.

6 Common Themes:

Emergency Access

Access for emergency vehicles will not be hindered during the event. This includes veterinary services.

Road Closure Timings

The timings of the road closures have now been published and are available to all. We advise people to plan ahead of the event any consider the timing of any key journeys that must take place on that day.

Pedestrian Access

Access by foot is not restricted during the event. We advise that anyone travelling on a closed road takes extra care when crossing for their own and the rider's safety.

Business Access

We are advising all businesses to plan ahead for the day and ensure that disruption is limited. We are available to help you plan and discuss any specific access needs.

FAQ's



Common Themes (continued):

Community Welfare

We are working with the County Council to reach out to care providers. We are working with them to ensure that journeys and shift times are planned ahead of the event. This includes private and voluntary carers.

Public Transport

Bus: We have now met with all major bus suppliers. Only 6 routes will be affected across the entire 100 miles and we are working with these companies to formulate a plan to maintain the best possible services.

Rail: We are also working with Railway companies to ensure that planned works are not scheduled for the event day. This will ensure that the railway can be utilised and no bus replacement services are scheduled.
