Project Title	Operation Watershed Parham Place
Description of issues, needs and/or initiatives :	

Flooding in 2019 was the result of run-off from the field located at the rear of Parham Place. This initially pools, and then overflowed following the path of least resistance through the development. Overwhelming the existing drainage and under the properties (through their air bricks) and out onto the public highway.

Provision of a mechanism to direct the surface water from the field to the existing ditch that runs parallel adjacent to the field.

Brief description of proposed works or activity:

- Break out existing concrete slab and dispose of arisings at licensed facility site
- Remove fallen tree across ditch and dispose of arisings off site
- Excavate new ditch and form adjacent bund using excavated material to specifications provided
- Install new ductile iron culvert. Pipe to be 225mm St Gobain or similar approved surround with 100mm ST concrete and backfilled with selected as-dug material
- Install new concrete bag headwalls to new culver. (Headwalls to be built in accordance with WSCC standard

The Parish Council has been aware of these issues for 2 years and have been liaising with the community throughout this time. 5 properties are affected.
