Project Title	New Barn Hill and New Road Junction Flood Relief, Westerton

Description of issues, needs and/or initiatives

Extensive flooding on corner of New Barn Hill and New Road, Westerton due to surface water being unable to flow as no drains under road to connect ditch to existing partial drainage system. Surface water gathers on the corner leading to ice forming in winter on the corner of the crossroads.

Brief description of proposed works or activity

Install new Headwall to ditch.

Install new sections of pipework and gullies to connect to existing network

Install new kerb apron to existing gully

Reprofile carriageway surface, add new radius kerb

Clear and excavate ditch line to increase capacity

Jet pipes, empty gully pots and chambers

How long has the community been aware of the issue or needs you aim to address?

More than 15 years, but worse in more recent years due to heavier rainfall, and lack of drainage capacity.

	Please see Notes within the B&M quote. B&M have included jetting and emptying which is an integral part of the job to ensure all is flowing at the time the work is done.
	It is assumed that as Landbuild have not shown this they believe that WSCC Highways will do the equivalent jetting and emptying. If so, would Highways be able to do this? And would they be able to do this at the time the work is carried out to ensure all is flowing?
	Both contractors discussed the work with Darren Norris of Goodwood estate.



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	£31,624 as B&M Plant quote is preferred. Otherwise £21,104.28 if Landbuild quote would have to be accepted, but on condition that WSCC do the jetting and emptying at the time of the works.

More residents in Westerton are now involved in their hamlet due to a new WhatsApp group and Volunteers are available to assist with remedial works if needed.
