



Year on Year Emissions Comparison

Commentary

- Recorded carbon emissions for the quarter totalled 5,107 tonnes*, amounting to a 25% decrease against the 19/20 baseline.
- A reduction in operational buildings, reduced demand from offices and maintenance works have all contributed to these savings, as have comparatively warmer temperatures reducing gas demand.
- Transport related emissions remain at less than 60% of pre-Covid levels, though this gap is closing as transport emissions trends upwards.
