Summary

The Communities, Highways and Environment Scrutiny Committee's Business Planning Group requested a report reviewing lessons learnt from completed major highway projects (such as the A2300 and A259), and confirmation that any arising learning has been identified and will be applied to future schemes.

Key Lines of Enquiry

- Whether learning been adequately captured from all project phases.
- Whether learning from other major schemes could add to the learning from the A2300 and A259 projects.
- Whether the responses to the lessons learned will in future sufficiently address the adverse event they are intended to remedy.
