## Additional Information on Household Support Fund

West Sussex County Council has been allocated £9.7 million in Round Four of the Household Support Fund by the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) covering the period 1 April 2023 until 31 March 2024. This funding must be spent in accordance with the specific grant conditions issued by the DWP.
