
What is Refill?

 A national initiative to enable the public to have to access drinking water when they are out

 Local businesses offer tap water refills for free and register their business on an app

 The general public can download the app to find local places to refill.

Why?

- Average person in the UK buys 150 plastic water bottles every year.
- Even recycling them is a drain on resources
- But many end up in our rivers and oceans
- If just one in ten Brits refilled once a week, we'd have 340 million less in circulation
- Refill is on a mission to inspire social change back to tap water



What's happening locally?

- Organisations are coming together to make Refill happen in West Sussex:
 - Community organisations
 - District and Borough Councils
 - West Sussex County Council
 - Water companies
- Towns and cities are signing up their own Refill schemes to encourage businesses to take part:
 - Horsham, Worthing and towns in Mid Sussex are already running
 - Arundel, Crawley, Bognor Regis are on their way
