- The Leader attended the '**SussExport - Sussex in the global marketplace**' event hosted by Wilton Park at Wiston Estate, Steyning on 8 July. Government Ministers, business leaders and trade ambassadors supported the event. The Leader joined the Sussex Growth Panel, together with Mims Davies MP and Ana Christie, Chief Executive of Sussex Chamber of Commerce. The discussion included local support and strategies in place to help grow businesses.

Public Health and Wellbeing – Bob Lanzer

- **Avian Influenza in wild birds** has been increasing over recent weeks, with growing incidents in the South East. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) advises that this is primarily a disease of birds and the risk to the general public's health is very low. Members of the public are advised to avoid contact with dead or visibly sick birds, reporting any found to the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) helpline (03459 33 55 77). The County Council is working closely with district and borough councils across West Sussex on arrangements for safe disposal and co-ordination of the response led by DEFRA.
